Please return all library books by the end of term.

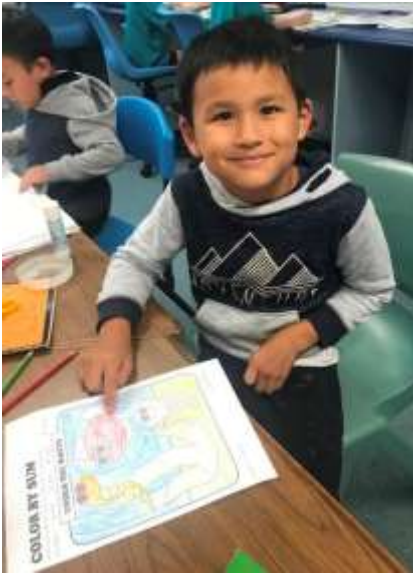
Students must wear hats for all outdoor activities. School hats are available to purchase for \$15 from the office.
