Halifax State School will receive

\$10,776

This funding will be used to

- Improve student outcomes for English from Year 1 to Year 6 to 100% of students achieving 'C' or above and 40% achieving an 'A' or 'B' by the end of Semester 2, 2020.
- Use high yield writing, grammar and punctuation strategies through an inquiry cycle.
- Staff unpack the writing domains of the Literacy Curriculum to provide clarity for teaching the elements of writing.
- Students engaged in daily writing with a focus on grammar and punctuation.
- Develop student writing goals from pre-test assessments.
- Provide explicit written and oral feedback aligned to the student writing goals.
- Moderate writing task through collaborative networks with schools in the cluster.

Our initiatives include

- Implement focused and intensive teaching for students requiring additional support to achieve "B" or "A" in the curriculum. (Australian Curriculum Version 8)
- Improve learning outcomes with an emphasis on explicitly teaching the writing demands of the curriculum. (Literacy Continuum – Aspects of Writing)
